



2019 New Orleans Jazz & Heritage Foundation Archive Fellowships

Fellowship Purpose

The Jazz & Heritage Archive Fellowships are scholarly grants of up to \$5,000 that are designed to make use of and contribute to the collection in the Jazz & Heritage Archive. The fellowships are intended for scholars who have demonstrated a remarkable capacity to document cultural and artistic aspects of New Orleans and/or Louisiana, through productive scholarship via public presentations, publications or exhibitions.

Applicants are encouraged to familiarize themselves with the Jazz & Heritage Archive's resources. Many of our collections are on our online catalog and can be found at <http://www.jazzandheritage.org/archive>.

Applicants are also welcome to speak to the Archivists or visit the Archive.

Eligibility

Applicants can be either academic or independent scholars with a considerable record of achievement.

How to Apply

When the application opens on Wednesday, January 2, 2019, go to the Foundation's site in FluidReview at <https://new-orleans-jh.fluidreview.com> to sign up, create a profile and start an application.

Fellowship Outline

We will award up to two fellowships annually for \$5,000 each. Incomplete or late applications will not be reviewed. Fellows must provide a mid-project report or presentation.

Important Dates

- Application open: Wednesday, January 2, 2019
- Application deadline: Sunday, February 3, 2019
- Award notification: Monday, March 25, 2019

The Fellowship program has three purposes. First is to encourage the scholarly use of the collections in the Jazz & Heritage Archive. Second is to support new documentation projects that produce primary resource material of lasting value for future research use in the Jazz & Heritage Archive. Third is to encourage scholarship regionally.

While the Jazz & Heritage Archive resources should play a central role in the proposed research agenda, fellows are also encouraged to explore other research facilities in the Greater New Orleans area. Some of the Jazz & Heritage collection is not in our online catalog; all applicants are encouraged to call the Archive to discuss additional materials of interest.

Archive Mission

The New Orleans Jazz & Heritage Foundation Archive is an educational service that identifies, collects, preserves and protects materials of cultural and historical significance to New Orleans and Louisiana as well as the records of the New Orleans Jazz & Heritage Foundation and its assets and programs. These

materials are to be used solely for scholarly research and interpretation and to support the mission of the New Orleans Jazz & Heritage Foundation.
